ART EXHIBIT OPENING Kai Yokoyama would like to invite the congregation of Wallingford Presbyterian Church to the opening reception for an exhibition of this father Tokujiro Niishi's art at Drexel University on Thursday, August 9th from 5-7 pm at the Paul Peck Alumni Center. From the Drexel Collection's website, "As a member of the Sakujitsu-Kai artists' group, Nishi's paintings embody the shared styles of traditional Japanese oil painting and the western-styles of Post-Impressionism and Neo-Expressionist artists." The exhibition itself will be running from 8/9 through 12/14.

The Next BookLook will be held on Wednesday, August 22 at 7:30 pm. The book chosen is "Commonwealth" by Ann Patchett. Here is an abbreviated summary from Amazon: "One Sunday afternoon in Southern California, Bert Cousins shows up at Franny Keating's christening party uninvited. Before evening falls, he has kissed Franny's mother, Beverly—thus setting in motion the dissolution of their marriages and the joining of two families. Spanning five decades, Commonwealth explores how this chance encounter reverberates through the lives of the four parents and six children involved... When, in her twenties, Franny begins an affair with the legendary author Leon Posen and tells him about her family, the story of her siblings is no longer hers to control. Their childhood becomes the basis for his wildly successful book, ultimately forcing them to come to terms with their losses, their guilt, and the deeply loyal connection they feel for one another." Commonwealth is a meditation on inspiration, interpretation, and the ownership of stories. It is a brilliant and tender tale of the farreaching ties of love and responsibility that bind us together.
