The Association of Puerto Ricans on the Move (APM) serves 40,000 Philadelphians annually, operates on a combined budget of more than \$65 million, employs 400 multilingual, skilled and dedicated professionals and offers an extensive range of bilingual and culturally sensitive services at 13 sites throughout North Philadelphia and Montgomery County. APM programs include affordable housing, food security, employment assistance, early child education and daycare, foster care and adoption, substance abuse treatment and behavioral health for adults. ASSISTING ERITREAN REFUGEES and ASYLUM SEEKERS in MANY COUNTRIES The America Team for Displaced Eritreans

Eritreans continue to flee acute oppression (religious and political) and end up in a desperate situation with little food and security. The America Team assists now with a family of 8 in Uganda, 10 men stuck in war torn Yemen, families in Somali- land, two young women in Cuba, etc. Donations are also used to help Eritreans in process of seeking asylum in the United States: they are in federal detention and money is provided for making phone calls to family and lawyers, for postage and for bus fare, once released. The America Team is deeply involved assisting with the crisis of thousands of Eritreans trapped in Libya.

SUPPORTING FREEDOM FOR GIRLS New Life Center Foundation : Thailand

The New Life Center Foundation works exclusively with young ethnic minority women throughout the Mekong sub-region (Thailand, Burma, China, and Laos) who are at risk for, or victims of, human trafficking, forced labor, and sexual abuse. Since its inception in 1987, the NLCF has partnered with the Royal Thai Government and international NGOs to provide legal, psychological, and repatriation assistance.
